Narrative:

On 08 August 2019 at approximately 2200 hours I arrived at the above location and contacted Officer M. Espinoza #474, who conducted an initial walkthrough of the scene. On the exterior of residence located in the rear secured yard I observed that the bedroom window was broken. In the interior of the residence I observed light ransacking to the bedroom, living room, and kitchen area.

I took color digital photographs of the exterior and interior of the residence focusing on the disturbed areas. I then collected one plastic zip lock bag located on the bed and one empty wine bottle located on the kitchen counter. Per the victim, both of these items had been disturbed by the suspect.

I completed my final walkthrough and cleared the scene.

Ventura County Medical Center

On 08 August 2019 at approximately 2300 hours I arrived at VCMC CARDIAC room #1 and contacted Officer J. Rodriguez #430. I observed _____ lying on the hospital bed. I observed injuries to the face, right arm, and lower right leg.

I took color digital photographs of the injuries and cleared the scene at approximately 2400 hours.

ESPINOZA / 474

ON 8/8/19, AT ABOUT 2026 HOURS, I RESPONDED TO ASSIST OFFICERS ON SCENE OF A RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY. FOR DETAILS REGARDING THE INITIAL INCIDENT, PLEASE REFER TO OFFICERS HAIN'S, JC RODRIGUEZ', AND DILLARD'S REPORTS. I ARRIVED ON SCENE AND CONTACTED THE WHO TOLD ME ESSENTIALLY THE FOLLOWING:

LEFT HER RESIDENCE AT APPROXIMATELY 1715 HOURS TO GO TO SANTA PAULA TO HAVE DINNER. RETURNED AT APPROXIMATELY 2000 HOURS, PARKED VEHICLE, AND WALKED FROM RESIDENCE AT DOWN TO COLLECT HER MAIL AT THE CORNER OF LOMA VISTA AND TULANE.

WALKED BACK TO HER RESIDENCE AND APPROACHED HER FRONT DOOR. FRONT DOOR WAS LOCKED AND SHE NEEDED A KEY TO UNLOCK IT. ONCE SHE UNLOCKED THE FRONT DOOR, SHE WALKED INSIDE INTO HER FRONT BEDROOM. INITIALLY, DID NOT NOTICE ANYTHING OUT OF PLACE UNTIL SHE WALKED FROM HER BEDROOM INTO HER OFFICE / KITCHEN AREA.

OBSERVED HER ARMOIRE, WHICH HELD HER SHOES, HAD AN OPEN DOOR. BELIEVED THAT WAS ODD BECAUSE SHE TYPICALLY DOES NOT LEAVE THE ARMOIRE DOOR OPEN. PLACED HER FOOD FROM DINNER ON THE KITCHEN COUNTER AND WALKED BACK INTO HER BEDROOM. ONCE SHE WAS BACK IN HER BEDROOM, REALIZED THERE WAS BROKEN GLASS AT THE FOOT OF HER BEDROOM WINDOW. ONCE REALIZED THERE WAS A BROKEN WINDOW TO HER BEDROOM, SHE IMMEDIATELY EXITED THE RESIDENCE LEAVING THE FRONT DOOR OPEN. WALKED DOWN THE 20-30 FEET CONCRETE WALKWAY TO A YARD GATE WHICH SHE CLOSED BEHIND HER. AT THIS POINT, WAS NOW IN THE FRONT YARD OF THE RESIDENCE AND THE GATE THAT LEADS TO HER REAR ATTACHED RESIDENCE WAS CLOSED.

ONCE CLOSED THE GATE, SHE TURNED BACK AROUND AND OBSERVED A MOTION LIGHT HAD JUST BEEN ACTIVATED. THE MOTION LIGHT WAS SET TO THE SOUTHEAST OF HER BEDROOM WINDOW, ON THE OUTSIDE. HER BEDROOM WINDOW WAS ON THE EAST SIDE OF HER RESIDENCE. THE MOTION LIGHT WAS TUCKED ALL THE WAY BACK A NARROW WALKWAY AGAINST THE SOUTHERNMOST PROPERTY FENCE LINE, EAST OF HER BEDROOM WINDOW. FELT IT WAS ODD THE MOTION LIGHT TURNED ON SINCE THE MOTION LIGHT WAS ON THE OUTSIDE OF HER BEDROOM WINDOW AND TOO FAR FOR HER TO HAVE ACTIVATED IT. BELIEVED IT WAS POSSIBLE WHOEVER WAS INSIDE OF HER RESIDENCE WAS HIDING WHEN SHE WAS INITIALLY IN THERE AND THAT PERSON MAY HAVE EXITED THE RESIDENCE ONCE LEFT, WHICH ACTIVATED THE MOTION-SENSOR LIGHT.

REMAINED IN THE FRONT YARD UNTIL I CONTACTED HER. AFTER THE SUSPECT, WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE HOSPITAL, I HAD STAND BY OUTSIDE OF THE RESIDENCE UNTIL THE CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATION TECHNICIAN WIMER ARRIVED ON SCENE TO PROCESS IT.

TECHNICIAN WIMER TOOK PHOTOGRAPHS AND PROCESSED THE INSIDE AND OUTSIDE OF THE RESIDENCE AND ALLOWED INSIDE WITH HER IN

ORDER TO CONDUCT A WALKTHROUGH OF THE RESIDENCE TO FIND ITEMS WHICH WERE OUT OF PLACE. POINTED OUT A PLASTIC BAG OF JEWELRY NEAR THE SOUTH SIDE OF HER BED ON THE FLOOR. KNEW THAT BAG OF JEWELRY WAS OUT OF PLACE AND TAKEN FROM HER JEWELRY BOX. THE PLASTIC BAG WHICH CONTAINED THE JEWELRY WAS TAKEN INTO EVIDENCE BY TECHNICIAN WIMER. IN THE KITCHEN THERE WAS AN OPEN BOTTLE OF WINE WITH A CORK ON THE KITCHEN FLOOR. DID NOT OPEN THE BOTTLE OF WINE AND REALIZED IT HAD BEEN TAKEN FROM INSIDE OF THE RESIDENCE AND LIKELY CONSUMED BY SINCE DID NOT OPEN AND DRINK THE WINE AT ANY POINT ON THIS DATE. THE BOTTLE OF WINE WAS TAKEN FOR EVIDENCE AND PROCESSED BY TECHNICIAN WIMER. ONCE WIMER WAS COMPLETED WITH PROCESSING THE SCENE, THE RESIDENCE WAS TURNED BACK OVER TO

PHOTOGRAPHS WERE TAKEN BY TECHNICIAN IMER AND OFFICERS ON SCENE AND THOSE PHOTOGRAPHS TAKEN BY OFFICERS WERE UPLOADED TO EVIDENCE.COM.

CONFIRMED WHO WAS INSIDE OF HER RESIDENCE, MOVED JEWELRY FROM HER JEWELRY BOX, PLACED THEM INSIDE OF A PLASTIC BAG, AND LEFT IT ON THE GROUND NEAR THE SOUTHSIDE OF HER BED. WINE WAS ALSO TAKEN FROM INSIDE OF THE RESIDENCE AND CONSUMED WHILE WAS INSIDE. THE DOORS TO HER ARMOIRE AND CLOSET WERE ALSO OPENED AND PAPERWORK ON DESK WAS RIFLED THROUGH AS IF WAS LOOKING FOR PROPERTY TO TAKE. THE WINDOW WHICH WAS BROKEN WAS LIKELY THE ENTRY POINT FOR INTO THE RESIDENCE. ONCE FORCED ENTRY INTO THE RESIDENCE, BASED OFF THE EVIDENCE FOUND BY TECHNICIAN WIMER, IT APPEARED ENTERED THE RESIDENCE WITH THE INTENT TO COLLECT JEWELRY AND STEAL IT. CONFIRMED WITH ME AND TECHNICIAN WIMER THE JEWELRY WAS ORIGINALLY LOCATED IN JEWELRY BOX AND WAS NOW PLACED INTO A PLASTIC BAG AND LEFT ON THE GROUND APPROXIMATELY 5-10 FEET FROM THE ORIGINAL JEWELRY BOX'S LOCATION.

ON 8/8/19, AT APPROXIMATELY 2026 HOURS, I RESPONDED TO A RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY IN PROGRESS AT IN THE CITY OF VENTURA.

ON 8/9/19, I RECONTACTED THE VICTIM, FOR A FOLLOWUP INVESTIGATION. AT APPROXIMATELY 2000 HOURS, I MET WITH AT HER HOME ON . WHILE STANDING OUTSIDE WITH I STARTED ASKING HER ABOUT THE EXTERIOR LIGHT THAT SHE SAW ON.

TOLD ME THAT SHE WAS STANDING OUT AT THE STREET AFTER EXITING HER RESIDENCE AND WAS LOOKING TOWARDS IT. SHE WAS LOOKING THROUGH THE SLAT IN THE WOODEN GATE TOWARDS HER FRONT DOOR. SAW ONE OF THE EXTERIOR MOTION LIGHTS TURN ON AS SHE WAS ON THE PHONE WITH THE POLICE. TO HELP CLARIFY WHICH LIGHT SHE SAW TURN ON, I HAD STAND APPROXIMATELY IN THE SAME SPOT TUESDAY IN THE NIGHT BEFORE AND I WALKED TOWARDS HER FRONT DOOR AND ACTIVATED EACH MOTION LIGHT INDIVIDUALLY. BELIEVED THAT IT WAS THE MOTION LIGHT ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE PROPERTY THAT SHE SAW TURN ON.

WHILE I WAS ATTEMPTING TO GET THE LIGHTS TO ACTIVATE, I NOTICED THAT SOMETIMES LIGHT ACTIVATED ONLY WHEN YOU'RE CLOSE AND OTHER TIMES LIGHT ACTIVATED WHEN YOU WERE APPROXIMATELY SEVEN TO EIGHT FEET AWAY.

I THEN HAD STEP INSIDE THE HOUSE AND WE STARTED TO WALK THROUGH ALL OF THE ITEMS THAT SHE FOUND OUT OF PLACE. THE FIRST THING I TALKED TO ABOUT IS HER JEWELRY. FOUND SIX SMALL ZIPLOC BAGGIES WITH JEWELRY IN THEM ON THE FLOOR ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF HER BED. ALL SIX BAGS WERE IN A LARGER BAG THAT WAS COLLECTED AS EVIDENCE. THE JEWELRY WAS NORMALLY KEPT IN THE LARGER BAG. REMEMBERS GOING THROUGH THAT JEWELRY THE NIGHT BEFORE, DECIDING WHAT JEWELRY TO WEAR BEFORE SHE LEFT THE HOUSE. PUT THE JEWELRY BACK ON TOP OF HER JEWELRY BOX, WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY SIX TO SEVEN FEET AWAY FROM WHERE SHE FOUND THE JEWELRY. KEPT HER JEWELRY IN THE ZIPLOC BAGGIES. SHE WAS CERTAIN THAT SHE PLACED THE JEWELRY BACK ON TOP OF THE JEWELRY BOX BEFORE SHE LEFT HER HOME AND THE ONLY WAY THEY COULD HAVE ENDED UP ON THE FLOOR WAS BY SOMEONE MOVING THEM.

CLOSED HER BLINDS ON THE BROKEN WINDOW WHILE I WAS THERE WITH HER. SHE TRIED TO OPEN THEM BACK AND UP THEY WERE STUCK. TOLD ME THAT SHE HAD NEVER HAD A PROBLEM WITH THE BLINDS BEFORE LAST NIGHT. A COUPLE OF THE INDIVIDUAL VERTICAL SLATS WERE OUT OF PLACE. THE ONES OUT OF PLACE MATCHED UP EXACTLY WITH THE BROKEN WINDOW, AS THOUGH SOMEONE KNOCKED THEM OUT OF PLACE WHILE CLIMBING THROUGH THE WINDOW.

ALSO REMEMBERED THAT WHEN SHE FIRST CAME INTO THE HOUSE SHE HAD A TO GO BOX OF FOOD WITH HER. SHE PLACED THE TO GO BOX ON THE TOP OF A WOODEN PEDESTAL RIGHT NEXT TO THE FRONT DOOR. WHEN WAS FINALLY LET BACK INTO HER HOME, THE TO GO BOX HAD BEEN

MOVED INTO THE KITCHEN AND WAS OPEN. NOTICED THAT THE
 VEGETABLES FROM HER FOOD WERE GONE. REMEMBERS EXACTLY
 HOW MUCH SHE HAD SAVED AND REALIZED THAT NIGHT THAT THE VEGETABLES
 WERE GONE; HOWEVER, THE RIBS HAD NOT BEEN TOUCHED.

ON THE KITCHEN COUNTER NEXT TO THE SINK FOUND AN EMPTY
 BOTTLE OF WINE. DID HAVE AN EMPTY SLOT IN HER WINE RACK.
 WAS NOT SURE IF THE BOTTLE SHE FOUND WAS FROM HER WINE RACK
 OR NOT. SHE COULD NOT REMEMBER IF THE SLOT WAS THERE PRIOR TO LAST
 NIGHT. DID GO THROUGH HER KITCHEN AND NOTICED THAT NONE OF
 HER CORK SCREWS OR WINE OPENERS HAD BEEN MOVED. THERE WAS A WOODEN
 CORK FOR THE WINE BOTTLE LOCATED ON THE KITCHEN FLOOR. IT IS UNKNOWN
 HOW THE BOTTLE OF WINE WAS OPEN AND EXACTLY WHERE IT CAME FROM.

WHILE I WAS TALKING TO HER CAME TO
 THE HOME. TOLD ME THAT WHEN HE REVIEWED THE VIDEO CAMERA
 FOOTAGE HE COULD CLEARLY SEE THAT THE SUSPECT, HAD
 NOTHING IN HER HANDS.

THEN WALKED INTO HER OFFICE AREA. SHE TOLD ME THAT LAST
 NIGHT SHE FOUND A SALT ROCK LAMP OF HERS THAT SHE KEEPS ON HER
 COMPUTER DESK ON THE FLOOR NEARBY. THERE WERE MULTIPLE STACKS OF
 PAPER THAT HAD ALSO BEEN PUSHED OVER AND RUMMAGED THROUGH ON THE
 DESK.

NEXT TO THE DESK, THERE WAS CLOTHING RACK. KEPT MULTIPLE
 SCARVES ON A HANGER. FOUND THESE SCARVES PILED ON THE

 HER SCARVES WERE HANGING BY COLOR AND BY PATTERN THE NIGHT BEFORE. IT
 APPEARED AS THOUGH THE CLOTHES WERE LEFT IN A PILE TO BE COLLECTED FOR
 LATER REMOVAL.

WHILE WAS GOING THROUGH HER HOME, SHE ALSO NOTICED THERE
 WAS A BELT ON THE MIDDLE THE FLOOR. THE NIGHT PRIOR I'D SEEN THAT BELT IN
 THE SAME AREA WAS LAYING
 HAD PLACED THE BELT ON HER BED THE NIGHT PRIOR BEFORE
 LEAVING HER HOME. WAS GOING TO WHERE THE BELT; HOWEVER,
 DECIDED TO WEAR A DIFFERENT BELT AND LEFT IT ON HER BED WITH A PAIR OF
 JEANS.

WENT INTO ONE OF HER STORAGE CLOSETS AND SHE NOTICED THAT A
 PIECE OF TAPE THAT WAS USED AS A LABEL ON ONE OF HER BOXES HAD BEEN
 TAKEN OFF THE BOX AND CRUMPLED UP AND LEFT IN A DIFFERENT LOCATION.
 WENT THROUGH THE BOXES AND DID NOT SEE ANYTHING OUT OF

WHILE INSIDE THE HOME WITH SHE WALKED BY HER WINDOW THAT
 WAS SMASHED. AS WALKED BY THE WINDOW, THE EXTERIOR MOTION
 LIGHT ACTIVATED. IT WAS THE SAME MOTION LIGHT THAT SAW
 ACTIVATE THE NIGHT PRIOR. ALSO RECALLED THAT AS SHE WAS
 STANDING OUT ON THE STREET SHE DISTINCTLY REMEMBERED SHUTTING THE
 SCREEN DOOR AS SHE RAN OUT OF HER HOME TO CALL THE POLICE. AS SHE STOOD
 OUT ON THE STREET. SHE HAD A VIEW OF THE SCREEN DOOR AND KNOWS FOR

CERTAIN THAT THE SCREEN DOOR NEVER OPENED OR CLOSED BETWEEN THE TIME SHE RAN OUT AND THE TIME SHE SAW THE MOTION LIGHT ACTIVATE OUTSIDE HER WINDOW.

WHILE STANDING OUTSIDE WITH [REDACTED] SHE MENTIONED THAT ONE OF HER STOOLS WHICH WAS UP ON LEDGE HAD BEEN BROUGHT DOWN JUST OUTSIDE THE WINDOW. THE STOOL WAS ALSO BROKEN, AS THOUGH SOMEONE USED IT AS A STEP STOOL. [REDACTED] KNOWS THAT THE STEP STOOL WAS NOT BROKEN OR DOWN OUTSIDE THE WINDOW THE NIGHT PRIOR. [REDACTED] STATED MULTIPLE TIMES WHILE I WAS WITH HER THAT SHE IS VERY PARTICULAR ABOUT THE WAY THINGS ARE STORED AROUND HER HOUSE. SHE ALWAYS MAKES SURE SHE HAS WALKING ROOM AND NOTHING IS OBSTRUCTING HER PATHS. THE PLACE WHERE THE STOOL WAS LEFT WAS DIRECTLY IN THE MIDDLE OF A WALKING PATH. [REDACTED] HAD ALSO POINTED OUT A BOX OF TEA THAT WAS NEXT TO HER WINE HAD ALSO BEEN MOVED. THE BOX HAD BEEN ROTATED 90 DEGREES FROM ITS ORIGINAL POSITION.

BASED OFF THE CONVERSATION WITH [REDACTED] IT IS CLEAR THAT [REDACTED] HAD RUMMAGED THROUGH THE ENTIRE HOME. SHE HAD ENTERED EACH OF THE ROOMS AND HAD SELECTED MULTIPLE ITEMS FROM EACH ROOM AND PLACED THEM TOGETHER AS THOUGH THEY WERE BEING READY TO BE TAKEN OUT ALL AT ONCE.

TOLD ME THE FOLLOWING IN SUMMARY:

TOLD ME THAT HE RESIDED IN THE FRONT RESIDENCE OF THE PROPERTY
WITH AND HIS DOG. RECEIVED A TEXT FROM
THAT SOMEONE WAS INSIDE OF HER RESIDENCE. ARRIVED AT THE
RESIDENCE AND WALKED TOWARD THE BACK PATIO OF HIS HOUSE AND HEARD A
FEMALE VOICE COME FROM INSIDE OF RESIDENCE. SAID THE VOICE
SOUNDED FEMALE AND IT SOUNDED AS IF SHE WAS ON THE PHONE. AND
GAVE OFFICER'S PERMISSION TO GO INTO THE RESIDENCE AND I ASKED
IF OR DOG WERE IN HIS HOUSE. TOLD ME THEY WERE

OFFICER DILLARD ALSO ARRIVED ON SCENE AND I REQUESTED THAT OFFICER DILLARD WALK AROUND TO THE REAR OF THE RESIDENCE AND HOLD ON LOMA VISTA IN THE EVENT A SUSPECT ATTEMPTED TO FLEE OVER THE BACK FENCE. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ, K9 ROVER AND I APPROACHED ON FOOT AND OPENED THE SIDE WOODEN GATE. I USED MY FLASHLIGHT TO ILLUMINATE THE AREA AND I OBSERVED BOTH THE OUTSIDE METAL SCREEN DOOR AND THE INTERIOR WOODEN DOOR PARTIALLY OPEN. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ GAVE MULTIPLE CLEAR K9 WARNING PRIOR TO SENDING ROVER INSIDE THE RESIDENCE

AT THIS TIME ROVER ENTERED THE RESIDENCE AND SEARCHED FOR SUSPECTS. I COULD SEE THERE WAS A WHITE BED INSIDE OF THE BEDROOM BUT I WAS TOO FAR TO SEE DETAILS OF THE INSIDE. I ALSO HEARD A FEMALE VOICE COMING FROM THE GENERAL DIRECTION OF THE RESIDENCE. I WAS UNABLE TO DETERMINE IF THE FEMALE VOICE WAS COMING FROM THE BACKYARD OF THE NEIGHBOR'S HOUSE OR THE VICTIM'S RESIDENCE.

ROVER ENTERED THE RESIDENCE AND BEGAN SEARCHING, AFTER A FEW MOMENTS, OFFICER RODRIGUEZ AND I NEARED THE FRONT DOOR OF THE RESIDENCE. AS I NEARED THE FRONT DOOR, I SAW A PERSON LAYING ON THE WHITE BED. I HAD MY FIREARM POINTED AT THE BURGLARY SUSPECT AND COMMANDED THE PERSON TO "SHOW ME YOUR HANDS". AFTER MY FIRST COMMAND, THE SUBJECT TURNED HER HEAD TOWARD ME, STARED AT ME AND DID NOT SHOW ME HER HANDS. I THEN COMMANDED HER TWO MORE TIMES AND THE SUSPECT STILL REFUSED. THE SUSPECT ON THE BED WAS LATER IDENTIFIED AS [REDACTED] HAD HER HANDS NEAR HER WAISTBAND AND I FEARED THAT SHE MAY HAVE ACCESS TO A WEAPON. I KNOW BASED ON MY TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE, THAT BURGLARS USUALLY CARRY WEAPONS SUCH AS FIREARMS AND KNIVES AND COMMONLY CARY BURGLARY TOOLS SUCH AS CROWBARS AND SCREWDRIVERS. I OBSERVED K9 ROVER THEN LUNGE HIS HEAD TOWARD [REDACTED] FACIAL AREA. I WAS UNABLE TO SEE IF ROVER TOOK HOLD OF [REDACTED] FACE HOWEVER I THEN SAW ROVER APPREHEND [REDACTED] ON THE RIGHT ARM AND SHE STARTED TO YELL INAUDIBLE WORDS. K9 ROVER THEN PULLED [REDACTED] OFF OF THE BED TOWARD THE OPEN FRONT DOOR AND BOTH HER AND ROVER STARTED TO MOVE AWAY FROM VIEW TOWARD THE KITCHEN AREA.

I WAS ABLE TO RECOGNIZE [REDACTED] FROM HER CLOTHING DESCRIPTION FOR THE LAST CALL AS WELL AS A

UPON ARRIVAL, I INITIALLY TOOK A PERIMETER POSITION ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE RESIDENCE. WHILE STANDING ON LOMA VISTA ROAD, DIRECTLY TO THE REAR OF THE HOUSE, I COULD HEAR OFFICER RODRIGUEZ AND OFFICER HAIN FROM THE FRONT OF THE HOUSE MAKING ANNOUNCEMENTS INTO THE HOUSE.

OVER THE RADIO, I COULD HEAR THAT OFFICER HAIN AND OFFICER RODRIGUEZ HAD CONTACTED A SUBJECT INSIDE THE HOUSE. I RAN TO THE FRONT OF THE HOUSE TO ASSIST THEM. WHEN I ENTERED INTO THE FRONT DOOR, I SAW FEMALE, _____ LAYING ON THE FLOOR.

_____ I CONDUCTED A SECONDARY SWEEP OF THE ROOM SHE WAS IN FOR ANY ADDITIONAL PEOPLE, NO ONE ELSE WAS FOUND INSIDE THE RESIDENCE.

WHILE FIRE AND PARAMEDIC PERSONNEL WERE TREATING _____ I PHOTOGRAPHED THE SCENE. I SAW THAT THERE WAS A BROKEN WINDOW ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE HOME. THERE WAS A LARGE AMOUNT OF GLASS INSIDE OF THE ROOM. I ALSO SAW AN OPEN TO GO FOOD CONTAINER SITTING ON THE KITCHEN COUNTER TOP.

ON 8-8-19, AT APPROXIMATELY 2031 HOURS, OFFICER HAIN AND I WERE DISPATCHED TO A RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY INVESTIGATION AT

AS I ARRIVED ON SCENE I CONTACTED OFFICER HAIN WHO TOLD ME HE HAD SPOKEN TO THE RESIDENT, WHO TOLD HIM THAT SHE HAD ARRIVED HOME AND ENTERED HER RESIDENCE VIA THE FRONT LOCKED DOOR. ONCE INSIDE SHE NOTICED A BROKEN WINDOW AND GLASS INSIDE OF HER BEDROOM. SHE THEN RAN OUT AND CONTACTED POLICE IN ORDER TO CHECK HER RESIDENCE OF ANY POSSIBLE SUSPECTS INSIDE. HER RESIDENCE WAS A STANDALONE HOUSE LOCATED IN THE BACKYARD OF

DUE TO FACT THAT THERE WAS BROKEN GLASS INSIDE OF THE RESIDENCE I WENT TO RETRIEVED MY POLICE CANINE AND PUT PROTECTIVE FOOTWEAR ON HIS PAWS. WHILE DOING SO I HEARD OFFICER HAIN ADVISE POLICE DISPATCH THAT THE RESIDENT WHO RESIDES IN THE FRONT HOME, LOCATED ON THE PROPERTY, HAD ARRIVED HOME AND WAS HEARING VOICES COMING FROM RESIDENCE. BASED ON THIS UPDATED INFORMATION I IMMEDIATELY RETRIEVED MY POLICE CANINE, HAVING ONLY PUT PROTECTIVE FOOTWEAR ON HIS FRONT PAWS, AND BEGAN APPROACHING THE RESIDENCE AT THE NORTHEAST LOCATION OF THE RESIDENCE WITH OFFICER HAIN WHILE OFFICER DILLARD TOOK A POSITION ON THE SOUTH PORTION OF THE PROPERTY. I OPENED THE FENCE LEADING INTO THE BACKYARD WHERE THE REAR RESIDENCE WAS LOCATED AND COULD SEE A SCREEN DOOR OPEN AND THE FRONT DOOR AJAR. BASED ON THE FACT THAT BURGLARY SUSPECTS OFTEN CARRY WEAPONS SUCH AS HANDGUNS AND KNIVES ALONG WITH BURGLARY TOOLS LIKE CROW BARS AND SCREWDRIVERS I MADE THE DECISION TO USE MY POLICE CANINE TO SEARCH THE RESIDENCE. THE POLICE CANINE WOULD BE ABLE TO LOCATE ANY SUSPECTS HIDING BEHIND CLOSED DOORS WHEREAS OFFICERS WOULD HAVE TO OPEN THE DOOR AND BE EXPOSED TO POTENTIAL DANGER. THE CANINE GIVES OFFICERS A MARGIN OF SAFETY DURING THE SEARCH.

I MADE AN ANNOUNCEMENTS FOR ANYONE INSIDE OF THE RESIDENCE EXIT WITH THEIR HANDS UP BUT GOT NO RESPONSE. I THEN MADE A SECOND ANNOUNCEMENT ADVISING THE CANINE WOULD BE USED TO SEARCH THE RESIDENCE AND FOR ANYONE INSIDE TO EXIT WITH THEIR HANDS UP BUT AGAIN GOT NO RESPONSE. PRIOR TO DEPLOYING MY CANINE OFFICER HAIN AND I HEARD SOMEONE TALKING BUT WAS UNSURE IF IT WAS COMING FROM THE RESIDENCE EAST OF OUR LOCATION OR FROM INSIDE OF THE VICTIMS HOUSE. A FINAL WARNING / ANNOUNCEMENT WAS MADE. AGAIN NO RESPONSE. I THEN DEPLOYED MY POLICE CANINE TO SEARCH THE INTERIOR OF THE RESIDENCE FOR ANY POSSIBLE SUSPECTS.

MY POLICE CANINE ENTERED THE RESIDENCE AND BEGAN SEARCHING AND A SHORT TIME LATER EXITED AND SEARCHED THE EXTERIOR OF THE RESIDENCE BEFORE RETURNING INSIDE. OFFICER HAIN AND I WERE ILLUMINATING THE FRONT DOOR WITH OUR FLASHLIGHTS AND LIGHTS ATTACHED TO OUR PISTOLS. DURING THAT TIME I SAW MY POLICE CANINE JUMP ON THE BED AND I ATTEMPTED TO HAVE HIM JUMP OFF AND COME BACK TO ME FOR FEAR OF HIM RUINING THE FURNITURE BUT HE DID NOT OBEY THAT COMMAND. SEVERAL SECONDS LATER I HEARD A SCREAM AND I GAVE THE POLICE CANINE THE COMMAND TO TAKE HOLD OF THE SUSPECT. OFFICER HAIN AND I MOVED CLOSER TO THE FRONT DOOR AND I COULD SEE MY

POLICE CANINE HAD A HOLD OF THE SUSPECT'S RIGHT ARM WHO WAS LAYING ON THE BED ON HER BACK. I ORDERED THE SUSPECT TO BE STILL AND THEN ORDERED MY POLICE CANINE TO LAY DOWN. MY POLICE CANINE JUMPED OFF THE BED AND LAYED DOWN ON THE GROUND WHILE MAINTAINING HOLD OF THE SUSPECT'S RIGHT ARM. MY POLICE K9 SUBSEQUENTLY PULLED THE SUSPECT OFF OF THE BED AND BOTH CANINE AND THE SUSPECT WERE NOW ON THE GROUND IN THE BEDROOM. OFFICER HAIN AND I ENTERED THE RESIDENCE AND VISUALLY CLEARED AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE. I ATTACHED MY LEASH TO THE CANINE'S COLLAR AND GAVE HIM THE COMMAND TO RELEASE HIS HOLD AND WITHIN SECONDS HE LET GO AND OFFICER HAIN TOOK CONTROL OF THE SUSPECTS RIGHT ARM WHILE HER LEFT ARM WAS UNDERNEATH HER BODY. I STOOD BY NEAR THE KITCHEN WHILE MAINTAINING COVERAGE ON THE UNSEARCHED AREA TO MY RIGHT.

OFFICER HAIN PHYSICALLY SEARCHED THE REMAINDER OF THE RESIDENCE AND DEEMED IT CLEAR OF ANY ADDITIONAL SUSPECTS INSIDE. ADDITIONAL OFFICERS AND PARAMEDICS WERE REQUESTED TO TREAT THE INJURIES TO THE SUSPECT WHO WAS LATER IDENTIFIED AS
